

Inverter Change

When the system was originally installed and accredited, a grid application was submitted to NIE which states the declared export capacity, (DNC). Changing the inverter can affect the DNC. Please ensure that you state the correct declared export capacity on the commissioning certificate.

****Where an inverter is installed that increased the DNC an amended grid application should be made to NIE. Ofgem will require the third party DNC. It is therefore recommended that any new inverter is replaced on a like for like basis, i.e. does not increase the DNC.**
