

How to read your generation meter

Your generation meter is the meter your installer will have put in for you. This meter records all the units generated by your renewable system and it is the units from this meter that ROCs are paid on.

The generation meter reading is the default reading on this meter, you do not need to press any buttons.

How to read your import/export meter

Your import/export meter is the meter which was installed by NIE (it will probably say 'property of NIE' on the meter). We will contact you at the end of September each year to request your export meter reading.

Credit meter

If you receive an electricity bill then your import/export meter will look like the meter shown on the left.

To take your export meter reading please:

1. Press the blue button until you see a small '5' in the corner of the display.
2. The reading shown beside the small '5' is your export meter reading.

If your import/export meter does not have blue button like the meter above and is automatically scrolling between a **T** – reading and an **R** – reading please note that is the **R** – reading which shows your total exported units.



Economy 7

If you have an Economy 7 import/export meter, then the default reading on your meter (without pressing any buttons) is your export meter reading.

Keypad Meter

If you have a Keypad meter then your meter will look like the meter shown on the right.

To take your export meter reading please:

1. Press number '9' three times.
2. You should see 'Ex' in small writing in the corner of the display.
3. The meter reading displayed after 'Ex' is your export meter reading.
